## The Guildhall Singers:

Singing a range of religious and secular music, from early to Baroque, folk to jazz, Renaissance to contemporary, the Guildhall Singers were formed in 2019 by a group of experienced local singers led by Helen Herbert. "We wanted to have our own ensemble so we could choose music from a repertoire that is especially suited to a smaller group." Following their first concert in 2019 in support of the Bungalow project at St Faith's, Gaywood, the choir took part in the 'for one night only' 11<sup>th</sup> Hour Project, singing at several well-known venues in King's Lynn. It also performed in Christmas concerts supporting the Shakespeare's Guildhall Trust, True's Yard and twice for the Mayor's Trust: at the Town Hall with UK jazz legend Norma Winstone and at Ken Hill House. For the last two years the choir has enjoyed singing under the baton of Charlotte Şinassi-Hill, performing in St Peter's, Great Walsingham as well as St Mary's, South Wootton.
